It is my pleasure to present the second volume of the Performance Report of the Siliguri Municipal $Corporation\ on\ this\ momentous\ occasion\ of\ the\ completion\ of\ two\ years\ since\ the\ election\ of\ the\ current\ board.$ This report encapsulates the significant efforts we have made collectively in transforming Siliguri into a climate resilient, sustainable, and inclusive city. Over the past two years, the Siliguri Municipal Corporation has navigated through various challenges, demonstrating resilience, commitment, and a strong sense of responsibility towards the citizens we serve. In this volume, you will find detailed analyses of key performance indicators, highlighting the strides made in areas such as infrastructure development, waste management, urban planning, and community engagement which have enhanced the quality of life in Siliguri.

We have implemented a solid waste segregation program, complemented by the establishment of a state-of-the-art 200 TPD fresh waste processing facility. This not only addresses immediate waste management concerns but also contributes to our broader sustainability goals. At the same time, we ensure clean roads and surroundings through our team of cleanliness workers, Nirmal Sathis and Nirmal Bandhus. To address the sanitation needs of our growing population, we have established three decentralised sewage treatment plants (STPs) that aim to provide efficient and eco-friendly solutions to wastewater management. We have diligently worked towards ensuring a sustainable water supply aiming for 135 litres per capita per day through the 'AMRUT Mission', thus securing a crucial resource for the well-being of our residents. Recognizing the importance of renewable energy, we have successfully implemented a 25 kWp hybrid solar PV system which demonstrates our commitment to clean energy. Additionally, our ambitious project to convert streetlights to LEDs not only enhances energy efficiency but also ensures a safer and well-lit cityscape. We have undertaken numerous projects on road construction, upgradation, and repair, especially the bye-lanes and pocket roads of Siliguri, which emphasises our efforts to bolster the last mile connectivity, thereby ensuring accessibility for all. We have undertaken several slum development projects wherein we have extended basic services like water, electricity, toilets to the slum dwellers. Our social inclusion programmes include initiatives such as 'MAA canteens' which provides affordable and nutritious meals, 'Duare Sarkar' which is a doorstep delivery system for essential government services, NULM and other schemes which enables women and EWS citizens to be financially self-sufficient. Pensions for the elderly and widows have been increased, reflecting our dedication to supporting the most vulnerable sections of our society. The 'Banglar Bari' initiative strives to make housing affordable and accessible to all residents, ensuring that a secure and comfortable home is within reach for every citizen of Siliguri. Under the leadership of the Hon'ble Mayor, we have initiated several social outreach programmes like 'Talk to Mayor', 'Manusher Kachhe Cholo', 'Write to Mayor' and 'WhatsApp to Mayor' to redress the grievances of the citizens and increase accountability and transparency on our part. Through the 'Alor Dishari' programme we provide free coaching classes and necessary stationery to the students of classes IX and X across Bengali, Hindi and English medium schools.

The tireless dedication of the elected board, municipal officials, and every staff member of Siliguri Municipal Corporation has been instrumental in achieving the milestones outlined in this report. Our commitment to good governance, accountability, and citizen-centric policies remains steadfast, and we are determined to build upon these foundations in the years to come. As we celebrate this milestone, it is crucial to acknowledge the invaluable feedback and support received from the residents and stakeholders of Siliguri. We remain open to constructive feedback and look forward to continued partnership in our shared vision for a climate resilient, sustainable, and inclusive Siliguri. ACCOUNTS & FINANCE

Accounts & Finance is one of the departments of SMC which ensures SMC's smooth running through planning, organising, recording, monitoring and disbursement of fund. It not only pays the due bills of SMC but also maintains its accounts and prepares the budget for each financial year.

After taking charge of SMC in 2022, the current Board has played a significant role in managing planning, and controlling the income and expenditure of SMC. At the same time, it has also succeeded in increasing its own revenue generation in comparison to previous years. The details of own source revenues for the 3(three) consecutive years are given below:

ADVERTISEMENT

The Advertisement Department of Siliguri Municipal Corporation is responsible for verifying and authorising the advertisements across the city. An advertisement fee is charged to the advertisers for the same. Through routine inspections, any type of illegal hoarding and flex are immediately removed and dealt with as per law. The department generated a revenue of Rs 2.84 crore from 22nd February 2022 to 31st January 2024.

PARKING

Siliguri Municipal Corporation has **31 street parking** zones from which a revenue of **Rs 2.07 crores** has been generated from 22nd February 2022 to 31st January 2024.

TRADE LICENSE

As per section 118 of the West Bengal Municipal Act 1993 every person engaged or intending to be engaged in any profession, trade or calling within SMC area, should obtain a Certificate of Enlistment and get the same renewed annually. Similarly, as per Section 201 of the said Act, no person should use or permit to be used any premises for any of the non-residential purposes without or otherwise than in conformity with a license granted by SMC. During the tenure of the present Board the process of online issuance of Certificate of Enlistment was introduced through WB E-District portal. Through this portal citizens can easily obtain Certificate of Enlistment from anywhere without requiring to visit the SMC office premises. In this regard Borough Offices have been ensuring legacy data entry for old Certificate of Enlistment.

BANGLAR BARI

This project is also called Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) or Housing For All. The objective of this scheme is to provide pucca houses to eligible urban people as per the guidelines provided in the scheme. The contribution breakup of house construction is provided in the table below.

BIRTH & DEATH

All records of birth & death cases within SMC area are recorded by this department, which plays a major role for enumerating the population of Siliguri as well as gender ratio. During the tenure of the present Board, a new online portal has been launched by the name of "Janma Mrityu Tathya" since 06.05.2022. Currently people are applying online for obtaining birth and death certificates. During this period the department has issued a total of 7364 birth certificates and 3311 death certificates. Female births and deaths recorded were 3483 and 1341 respectively. Male births and deaths recorded were 3881 and 1970 respectively. From 1st January 2023 to 31st January 2024, SMC has provided Rs. 24 lakh as financial assistance to 1200 beneficiaries under the 'Samabyathi Prakalpa'.

BUILDING CELL

Urbanization and building plans are complementary to each other. The beauty of the city depends to a degree on constructions with aesthetic architectural design. Building construction is a huge industry which generate bulk amount of employment & revenue for the city. The Building Cell of Siliguri Municipal Corporation regulates the building activities in the area under its jurisdiction as per provisions of the West Bengal Municipal (Building) Rules (2007). As per the said Rules made under the West Bengal Municipal Corporation Act, 2006, it is mandatory for every citizen desirous of erecting a building or executing any work, to obtain prior permission from SMC. In case of failure to do so, the construction carried out shall be treated as unauthorized constructionwithin the meaning of the provisions of the Act. Approval of all new building plans, renewal of existing building plans and issuance of occupancy certificate is carried out following said Act, Rules and exact government quidelines. Strict actions are taken against unauthorized and illegal constructions. It is requested to all citizens of the city to collect occupancy certificates once their buildings are completed. The purchasers of ownership flats and commercial spaces are also requested to verify and comply with the approved plan and the occupancy certificate issued by SMC before purchasing the property. During the tenure of the present Board applying for a building permit has been made simpler through the OBPAS online portal which allows citizens to apply for the building permit from their own residences or offices. This process also ensures transparency and increases vigilance against corruption, as a result of which, during the tenure of the present Board, 1291 building plans have been approved which has generated a revenue of Rs 35.66 crores for SMC.





CONSERVANCY & VEHICLES

The Conservancy Department of Siliguri Municipal Corporation is concerned with waste disposal and waste management. This includes drain, roads and markets, vacant lands cleaning, vector control and ensuring cleanliness in public areas and timely collection of segregated waste from residential and commercial places.

Double Shift Work

Evening shift of Conservancy services has been introduced to maintain cleanliness in all the main roads and it was instructed to all the Boroughs to maintain a hygienic environment.

SWM Project

SMC is committed to ensure 100% of Siliguri's solid waste is collected and processed in a segregated manner to ensure climate and environmental resilience of the city. In this regard, SMC has undertaken the following initiatives

- **a.** The process of solid waste segregation among residential and commercial units in all 47 wards of SMC has been initiated as per the guidelines from SUDA and the Climate Resilient City Action Plan of Siliguri.
- **b.** To ensure better solid waste segregation, procurement of 50,000 pairs of blue and green bins of 10 litres capacity for distribution among various households in different wards of SMC is in process.
- **c.** Procurement of 1000 pairs of blue and green bins of 100 litres for all the bulk waste generators of different wards of SMC and the tender is under process.
- **d.** Adequate numbers of pedalled tricycles (PTCs) have been provided to cover all the areas of SMC for primary collection.
- **e.** 720 new tricycle vans with bins have been engaged for primary collection of solid waste by SMC with support from SUDA
- **f.** 677 Nirmal Bandhus have been deployed in all 47 wards to ensure 100% collection of solid waste
- **9.** 124 Nirmal Sathi have been engaged in all 47 wards to supervise the collection of solid waste
- **h.** SMC has engaged 98 secondary transportation vehicles (15 E-autos, 15 Tata Ace and 68 Intra) with segregated chambers for collection of dry and wet waste from all the 47 wards of Siliguri.
- i. Engagement of additional 68 garbage collection vehicles for collection of solid waste from different market areas including Siliguri Regulated Market and drain cleaning waste.
- **j.** Two vehicles for collecting solid waste from hotels and community/marriage halls and two vehicles for collecting solid waste from nursing homes are being used...
- **k** Tripartite Agreement for fresh waste management between SMC, Eastern Organic Fertilizers Private Limited and SUDA has been signed for processing of organic waste and inorganic waste. Segregated waste from different wards is transported to the fresh waste processing facility located in Ward 42.

Sewage Treatment Plant (STP)

Three STPs are being constructed for treating the wastewater in association with SJDA and KMDA. The wastewater running through all drains having outfalls in River Mahananda and its tributaries will be intercepted and diverted to these STPs for treatment adhering to West Bengal Pollution Control Board.

Dengue Bijay Abhijan

This programme has been launched to combat dengue and its activities include disinfection of different water bodies, cleaning vacant lands and reducing the spread of mosquitoes.

Pest and Disease Control

Lime and bleaching is distributed to all the Boroughs on a regular basis to support the 'Dengue Bijay Abhijan' and pest control.

Mahananda river and adjoining high drain cleaning

15 teams for cleaning purpose have been deployed

Vacant land and high drain

Special Central Team comprising 250 workers have been deployed

Conservancy activities during Durga Puja & other festivals

During all festivals additional manpower has been deployed for cleaning drains, roads, and surrounding areas of Puja Pandals

- f. Heavy duty pump for washing of vehicles on regular intervals 1 no.
- g. 6 nos. of battery operated toto is distributed in 5 boroughs and centrally for VCT and SWM awareness work, etc.

- **4.** On 14th October, 2023, Mahalaya was played in all 47 Wards under SMC area simultaneously at 4 AM.
- **5.** As part of Puja Parikrama 2023, prizes were distributed to the best three organizers of Durga Puja
- **6.** Alo Dishari Free Coaching Camp for meritorious students of Class IX & X was inaugurated 15.05.2023 in Siliguri Boys' High School.
- **7.**Rabibasariyo cultural programme 2023 has been inaugurated in 2023 and is organized on every 2nd and 4th Sunday at Surya Sen Park.
- 8. International Seminar on the grand occasion of 200th birth anniversary of Michael Madhusudan was jointly organized by Siliguri Municipal Corporation and Siliguri College, where recitation competition of Michael Madhusudhan's works was organized, and childrenwere awarded with 1st, 2nd and 3rd position. Exhibition on Life & Work of Poet Michael Madhusudhan was organized at Ram Kinkar Hall on 24th & 25th January 2024 with support from I&CA followed by a cultural programme on 25th January 2024 at Dinabandhu Mancha.

ELECTRICAL SECTION

Electrical Section of Siliguri Municipal Corporation is responsible for operation and maintenance of different electrical accessories as well as execute different electrical projects of SMC. This includes O&M of all streetlights, lights in all parks and gardens, health centers, fields, playgrounds, Kiran Chandra Crematorium & Kanchenjunga Stadium as well as all other properties of SMC. Apart from these, Electrical Section is also involved in various developmental projects such as illumination of parks and gardens, toilet blocks, installation of poles, mini-high-masts and high masts.

Some of the important projects of the Electrical Section are as follows:

- Installation of the 3rd furnace at K.C. Burning Ghat has been completed, amounting to Rs. 1.03 crores.
- The Electrical Section operates 31,902 streetlights atop 33,335 electric poles throughout the city. Among these lights, 25,875 are LED lights and 6027 are conventional lights. Separately there are 8 high mast lights. SMC has decided to replace the remaining 6027 conventional streetlights with LED streetlight sets, in a phase-wise manner.
- During 2023, 1000 LED sets had been purchased and conventional lights have been replaced for a net cost of Rs. 66.38 lakhs.
- During the same period, SMC has decided to install 200 PCC & steel tubular poles with 3 phase supply system at places where there are no uniform distribution system and adequate street light illumination amounting to Rs. 41 lakhs.
- This Section has been beautifying the street light poles with bi-coloured LED rope light chain at important main roads of different wards amounting to Rs. 18.94 lakhs.
- Temporary illumination for Chhat Puja Ghats at different wards under SMC area had been carried out effectively to satiate the religious yearning of the people of Siliguri.
 Along with temporary illumination & sound system for Durga Puja Carnival, the entire work amounted to Rs. 21.08 lakhs.

- A survey process has been undertaken to precisely identify any defect occurring in the street light poles maintained by SMC, it has been decided to mark the poles with appropriate numbering, such that the exact location of faults can be identified, and i ts swift maintenance can be carried out with ease.
- For a long time, there was a demand by residents of Siliguri to suitably illuminate the Burdwan Road. Accordingly, illumination of Burdwan Road from Jalpai More to Nauka Ghat has been completed which amounted to Rs. 29.58 lakhs.
- The tender worth Rs.20.60 lakh for illuminating Naukaghat to Tinbatti More is under process.
- Apart from the above, electrical wiring and necessary renovation & repairing of CDS
 offices, toilet blocks and health centres under SMC's jurisdiction are being carried out
 effectively with due diligence for the sake of public utility.
- Illumination of Eastern Bypass, from Parijat Statue to Roy Colony More, is ongoing andunder progress. The cost of the project stands at Rs. 12.89 lakhs.
- Underground cabling of all high-tension (HT) and low-tension (LT) electrical wires along the major roads of Siliguri like Hill Cart Road, Sevoke Road, Burdwan Road, and SF Road

ENVIRONMENT CELL

The Environment Cell of Siliguri Corporation plays a special role in protecting the environment of the city. Key responsibilities of the Cell include:

- Tree plantation programmes across the city
- Confiscation of illegal plastic bags
- Clean the city's rivers on a periodic basis,
- Deployment of stray dogs sterilisation programmes
- Remove the uprooted trees during disasters.

Some of the important activities undertaken during the present Board's tenure are as follows:

- 1. Special initiative was taken to streilise stray dogs and till around 800 stray dogs from different areas of the city have been sterilised and returned to their homes in healthy condition.
- 2. The board is particularly keen on tree plantation and over 1000 saplings have been planted across the city in the past year.
- 3. Forest Festival under the initiative of the West Bengal Government Forest Department and Siliquri Municipal Corporation was observed.
- 4. As a special innovation, trees that were required to be chopped down were instead replanted at other locations. The Cell has replanted 23 trees from their original place to another place, ie, beside the River Mahananda.

ESTABLISHMENT SECTION

The Establishment Section of SMC works for all staff related record keeping, services and welfare wing for all 2471 Permanent, Contractual & Casual staff. 12 designated staff work in the section and put their best effort to disburse monthly salaries for all categories of staff, honorarium of all councillors, pension and gratuity of retired/dead employees, and other remuneration, recording the promotion of existing staff, recruitment of new staff, and paying the premiums for various insurance policies like mediclaim policy, general provident fund, employees' provident fund. Some of key works of the section are as below:

- 1. To strengthen SMC's work and to extend uninterrupted services to its citizen, manpower has been increased by recruitment in various posts
 - a. 40 honorary health workers have been engaged on contractual basis to provide health awareness in SMC area.
 - b. 161 of high drain cleaning labourers have been engaged
 - c. 46 drivers have been engaged to ensure improved solid waste collection

GUEST HOUSES & BOOKING CELL

There are four guest houses, one community hall and one marriage hall, Kiran Chandra Bhawan, under the supervision of Guest House Booking Cell. All bookings of Siliguri and Kolkata guest houses are controlled by the Booking Cell. Hon'ble Mayor has decided to build a new Guest House in Kolkata with state of the art facilities for the benefit of the people of Siliguri. Work is already under progress for the same. Details of all facilities are provided below

- Pantho Niwas, Baghajatin Road, Siliguri has six AC deluxe rooms.
- Kanchenjungha Youth Hostel, Kanchenjungha Stadium, Bidhan Road,
 Siliguri has eight rooms of four occupancy each with attached bathrooms.
- Kiran Chandra Bhawan The Hon'ble Mayor after visiting the old Kiran Chandra Bhawan felt the building was in extremely dilapidated state and decided to demolish the old building and construct it anew. The new building is being constructed with provision of two banquet halls and to accommodate the Office of the Borough Committee No. II of SMC.
- Kanchenjungha Stadium Hall, Siliguri has two hall rooms which are leased out for various community events and purposes.
- Atithi Niwas, Kolkata is presently being renovated and a new building is being constructed with state of the art facilities for the benefit of the people of Siliguri
- Kshanikher Atithi, Office of the Borough Committee No. IV, Siliguri is a new guest house which has been constructed atop the Office of the Borough Committee No. IV and was inaugurated on 20.01.24 by the Hon'ble Mayor, SMC.

Apart from the aforementioned, the Booking Cell also leases out the Baghajatin Park, Ward No 17 and Suryanagar Ground, Ward No 23 for various community events and purposes.

HEALTH SECTION

The present Board of SMC was elected in the aftermath of the COVID pandemic and thus, realised that the Health Section has a crucial role to play in ensuring the city's overall development. As such, the present Board during its tenure of last two years has placed immense importance on developing the health infrastructure of the Siliguri. At present there are 10 functional UPHCs, 11 functional UHWCs and 2 functional Polyclinics in SMC area. An additional 2 UPHC, 32 UHWC and 3 Polyclinics have been proposed to be developed.

Some of the important achievements of the Health Section during the tenure of the present Board are as follows

10 UPHCs

Are functional through NUHM scheme of SMC

They provide regular immunization, community activities through 216 U-ASHAs and MAS members.

In addition, free doctor consultation, medicine and laboratory test facilities can be availed in these UPHCs.

A new cell counter machine and one additional ELISA machine has been installed in UPHC-9, Srinivash Seba Sadan to combat dengue. Another cell counter and ELISA Machine has been proposed for installation.

camps focused mainly for slum population in the wards catered by the UPHCs. 63,534 beneficiaries were covered through these outreach camps.

fever clinics have been organized in addition to daily fever OPDs in UPHCs to combat dengue outbreak

Chokher Alo camps for improved eye health has been conducted across various wards of Siliguri.

Two Polyclinics in UPHC-9 (Srinivas Seba Sadan) and UPHC-7 (Sri Guru Vidyamandir) are functional with X-Ray facilities and specialty services. These Polyclinics have specialist doctors for medicine, pediatrics, gynecologist, ophthalmologist, and a staff nurse in each of the polyclinic. Three new Polyclinics at UPHC-5, Matrisadan, Dabgram, UPHC-1, Tumol Para, Ward No 4 and UPHC-2 Salugara, Ward No – 42 SMC have been sanctioned in the FY 2023-24.

INFORMATION & TECHNOLOGY

The Information & Technology (IT) department is responsible for the development and implementation of software across all departments, Installation of LAN and WAN networks for any SMC activity, organizing video conferences and Talk to Mayor programme, uploading tenders on WB e-tender portal and GEM portal and specific initiatives like e-governance, web portal, ERP, MAS, SMC-NET, Data Centre, Disaster Recovery Centre, NIC Email, and reporting on various portal of government is carried out by the IT Department. A list of key activities carried out during the tenure of the present Board is given below:

- CCTV surveillance system has been installed at the SMC Head Office, Dumping Ground, Sitala Para Park, Siliguri Boys' High School, Siliguri Girls' High School, Court More surrounding area, Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat, Kiran Chandra Crematorium and various other places around the city to ensure safety of the citizens.
- Digital archiving and meta data creation of legacy documents of SMC as a first step towards transitioning to E-Office.
- Setting up of Bangla Sahayata Kendra (BSK) at the Offices of Borough Committee Nos. I, IV and V. The same will be introduced at the Offices of Borough Committee Nos. II and III in the future
- Online payment app for payment of fees for Birth & Death registration charges, Cesspool hiring charges, debris collection charges, water charges is being developed in the interest of citizens of Siliguri.
- A meeting has been convened with all internet & cable service operators
 to discuss matters like arranging the cable and internet wires in a
 systematic manner and enlisting registered service providers.
- Social media management and digital outreach programme has been started within the area of Siliguri Municipal Corporation to reach the citizens of Siliguri for ongoing and upcoming works of Siliguri Municipal Corporation
- Installation of wireless intercom system and internet connection in SMC
 Head Office for interconnectivity of various departments
- Installation of biometric attendance system to ensure timely attendance of SMC staff
- 30 computer sets have been purchased for smooth running of various Departments and Borough Offices of SMC
- Video conferencing setup completed at Head Office and all Borough Offices for better communication among SMC officials.

MARKET SECTION

The Market Section is one of the revenue generating sections of Siliguri Municipal Corporation. It also acts as a link between the stall holders and the various service providing departments like water supply, electricity, conservancy, trade license of SMC This section is also responsible for the execution of lease deed and mutation of stalls. The Section has generated a revenue of Rs 71.8 lakhs during the present Board's tenure. Some of the key activities of this period are as follows:

- 42% growth in terms of collection of total revenue.
- Execution of lease deed with Bank of Baroda with an enhancement of 30% rent after every 5 years.
- Inclusion of additional 17 markets other than the previous 16 markets for the collection of conservancy charges.
- For expeditious completion of some routine activities of the section a computer has been installed for the 1st time in this office. A data entry operator has also been deputed. This is facilitating early redressal of t he various activities related to the section, thereby b enefiting the stall holders.
- Initiative to lease out the stalls of Subhas Pally market undertaken
- Formation of a market committee at Haider Para market to resolve the various issues of the stall holders.
- Completion of joint survey of D.I Fund market with the official of land and land revenue and D.I Fund, Darjeeling

MUTATION & ASSESSMENT

In the Mutation section of the Department a main holding is converted to another holding either in part or full by charging an appropriate mutation fee. Further the Department allocates New Holding to those properties which were erstwhile unregistered. This Department is an important revenue generation source for SMC. Despite this, after the present Board came into power on 22nd February 2022, the mutation fee was decreased from 2% to 1% for the benefit of the general public of Siliguri. Later, mutation fee was **again decreased to 0.5% on residential properties** and **0.25% on gift deeds** and **1% on commercial properties**. Even after this drastic reduction, the Mutation section was able to increase its revenue collection to **Rs 20 crore** from 1 April 2022 and 31 January 2024. Other notable initiatives in public interest include

• Issue of holding numbers to the EWS households who were living on vest lands. This important initiative, which was suspended for many years, have helped the households to overcome their problems and avail trade license, electricity connection, water connection against their holding numbers.

Holding issued as 'Protiki patta' in Word no 1,Word no 7,word no 18 and Word no 28 of SMC at the rate of Re 1 to the EWS families residing on central government/railway lands.

Holdings have been issued to EWS families residing on state government vest lands.

new holdings have been issued for unassessed properties on registry lands in various wards of SMC.

Revenue generated per annum approximately as property tax.

• A Chart of Value of vest land has been prepared. Issuing holdings on vest land is conducted as per this Chart of Value.

- Notarial affidavit for legal heirs is now being accepted as an alternative to the Executive Magistrate affidavits.
- E- mutation service has been initiated through which citizens can apply for mutation service online thereby easing access to government services
- . Citizens who do not have computer access can avail themselves of the service from the nearest Bangla Sahayata Kendra or SMC Help Desk.

The Assessment section is relentlessly working to enhance the financial health of SMC by assessing land & buildings and also reviewing the objections raised by the assessees. To improve efficiency, the section has undertaken the following initiatives

- The Tax Review Committee of SMC has been constituted by the Hon'ble Mayor to address the grievances of citizens. This committee has received 18 such petitions of which 16 petitions have already been reviewed and adjudged.
- General Valuation of Land & Buildings is being conducted to update the register of all properties in Siliguri. The West Bengal Valuation Board (WBVB) is supporting SMC to conduct this initiative
- · GR survey work is in full swing under the supervision of WBVB




- The first phase of field survey has ended in all 47 wards of SMC through which 82,648 holdings out of 1,42,758 holdings have been surveyed,and 338 big and high potential holdings were surveyed in 22 wards of SMC. The second phase of the field survey has begun in ward numbers 6, 12 and 16.
- Digitisation of the collected data is underway through which 72,415 data entries have been completed.

After being elected on **22nd February 2022**, this Board re-started the patta survey work within SMC area which was kept in abeyance until then by its predecessor. During this Board's tenure it has been dealt the utmost priority and ULDC was reconstituted with the Hon'ble Mayor Shri Goutam Deb as the Chairman of ULDC. As a first step, a survey of **6270 affected** households was conducted which identified **1056 eligible** beneficiaries. The relevant documents for these **1056 EWS** families in various wards of SMC area have been sent, through the District Magistrates of Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri, to the state government for approval. It is expected that patta / lease deeds for all these cases will be ready for distribution among the beneficiaries within a very short period of time.

The property tax can be deposited by the citizens either at the SMC Head Office or any of their respective Borough Offices. Some key activities are as follows:

- Online collection of property tax has been started through Android POS machine and is running smoothly.
- Several distress warrant programme has been conducted to collect the outstanding dues from the defaulters.
- The total property tax collection has increased during the tenure of the present Board to Rs 29.3 crores as on 31st January 2024




PUBLIC WORK SECTION

The Public Works (PW) Section of Siliguri Municipal Corporation is responsible for managing the public infrastructure and facilities within the municipal corporation jurisdiction. The PW Section also plays a crucial role in the planning and implementation of long-term infrastructure projects and improvements. The department is responsible for ensuring that all public facilities are safe and accessible to the community, and that they are maintained and upgraded as necessary. Additionally, the PW Section works with other departments within the SMC, as well as with government agencies and community organizations, to ensure that projects are completed on time, within budget, and in compliance with relevant regulations and standards. The goal of the PW Section is to enhance the quality of life for residents and visitors by providing safe, functional, and aesthetically pleasing public spaces, while ensuring that the municipal corporation infrastructure and facilities are well-maintained and up-to-date.





URBAN POVERTY ERADICATION (UPE) CELL





This is a special micro-credit facility plan to provide affordable loans of upto **Rs 10,000** per person to vendors, hawkers, and people involved in goods and services related to textiles, apparel, artisan products, barbers shops, laundry services, etc. This scheme aims to provide affordable working capital to street vendors who are left affected by the covid 19 pandemic. The loanee need not provide any collateral security to access the loan and will get an interest subsidy of 7% at early or timely repayment of loans. A loanee has a high probability of being eligible for an increased loan if s/he repays the first loan on time. Monthly cashback in the range **of Rs.50 to 100** is an incentive for digital payments. 

WATER SUPPLY

The **Water Supply** Department provides wholesome safe potable water to the citizen under SMC area. The Public Health Engineering Dierctorate (PHED) is the executing agency on behalf of Siliguri Municipal Corporation & looks after the operation and maintenance of the water treatment facilities of SMC.

The **Water Supply** Department provides service connections to the intended citizens and monitors the day to day works of **water supply**.

There are a total of 42,115 house connections under SMC area.

To eliminate the iron content from the deep tube well water of Chandmoni, in ward no 47, an initiative has been taken to install an iron removal plant the work has been completed & expected to be commissioned soon.

To minimize the financial load to some extent on the citizens, the monthly water charge of residential water connection has been waived from April 2022

Details of some of the flagship projects are appended below:

A. Augmentation of water supply scheme (Phase-I) for Siliguri Municipal Corporation under AMRUT II.

Due to scarcity of water from the existing intake and also to meet up the increased water demand this project was undertaken to ensure water supply to SMC area & en-route villages. The project proposes an alternate raw water intake at Gajoldoba and construction of an additional WTP at Fulbari to enhance the supply rate with construction of additional overhead reservoirs and augmentation of distribution system.

RS 511.08 Crores

Total sanctioned amount of the project

Tender floated on EPC Turnkey basis for construction of intake well, pump house, approach jetty, electrical substation and supplying, laying of raw water main from intake to WTP with Construction of pipe bridges. The scope of the work also encompasses all survey, design, civil construction, electromechanical works including 3 months trial run and 5 years O&M. Physical on ground work has commenced.

B. Siliguri Comprehensive Municipal Corporation Water Supply Scheme.

Includes laying of MS pipe line & subsequent execution of Electromechanical works & allied works for both (Civil & Mechanical) components in connection with alternative arrangement of Raw Water supply from tail regulator on Teesta-Mahananda Link Canal to Fulbari Water Treatment plant (WTP) at Fulbari.
